

## **Build4Scale Website Terms of Use & Privacy Policy**

Welcome to the Build4Scale.org website! The U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE's) Build4Scale™ training teaches manufacturing fundamentals to energy hardware innovators. The consolidated online training provides scientists and engineers with the knowledge they need to assess manufacturing readiness, make and evaluate smart product design decisions, and engage with manufacturing partners.

Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory, which is managed and operated by Lawrence Livermore National Security, LLC ("LLNS"), led the development of the Build4Scale training materials and website along with more than a dozen partners.

### **Definitions**
